EXISTING ACT 1958, MODEL ACT AND UP AGRICULTURE UNIVERSITY ACT 2014
PREPARED BY UPCAR (based on the recommendations of the Committee comprising
Dr. R.S. Paroda, Dr. Panjab Singh, Dr. H.S. Gupta and Dr. M.P. Yadav)**
